# **MAJOR GENERAL GREGORY M. GUILLOT**

Maj Gen Gregory M. Guillot is the Deputy Commander, U.S. Air Forces Central Command, and Deputy, Combined Force Air Component Commander, U.S. Central Command, Southwest Asia. As Deputy Commander, he is responsible for the command and control of air operations in a 20-nation area of responsibility covering Central and Southwest Asia, to include Operation Resolute Support in Afghanistan and Operation Inherent Resolve in Iraq and Syria.

General Guillot received his commission in 1989 from the U.S. Air Force Academy. He has commanded a flying squadron, Operations Group, and two flying Wings. He has served on the NAF, MAJCOM, Air, and COCOM staffs, was a USAF Weapons School instructor, and is a graduate of the National War College. Prior to his current assignment, General Guillot was the Chief of Staff, Headquarters Pacific Air Forces, Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii.

General Guillot is a senior air battle manager with more than 1,380 flying hours.
