

## "Who Qualifies to Live in Government-Leased Housing?"

According to Air Force Instruction 32-6001, Family Housing Management, there are three categories of persons who can live in government-leased housing:

- 1) DoD Sponsor and their spouse, unmarried children, or parent(s) who qualify the sponsor for dependent-rate housing allowances.
- 2) Social visitors for up to 30 days (visits exceeding 30 days require approval of the installation commander).
- 3) Live-in childcare provider (nanny). It is important to note that AFI 32-6001 requires residents who wish to employ a live-in childcare provider to obtain prior approval from the installation commander (in our case, the 379 AEW/CC). Requests are required to be coordinated with the Installation Judge Advocate and Security Forces (a template is provided). Approval of a live-in childcare provider does not constitute justification for an additional bedroom entitlement.
