

PET INFORMATION

- All domestic breeds of cats are allowed into Qatar with no problems
- Some breeds of dogs are restricted, so are only allowed into Qatar for owners who have an American or European passport and can prove they are neutered family pets. These breeds include ALL bulldog, mastiff & "bull terrier" breeds along with great danes, Rhodesian ridgebacks, boxers, cane corsa, akitas, chows etc along with mix breeds containing any of these heritages
- Small domestic animals (hamsters, guinea pigs etc) can be imported but require extra permissions but as far as we are aware, pet mice and rats are not allowed at all
- Birds can be imported from some countries provided they have the correct paperwork - currently there is a ban on all birds being imported from the USA for example
- Some exotic types of pets (lizards, snakes etc) can occasionally be shipped in with extra permissions and paperwork but others are completely banned (bobcats, foxes, marmosets etc)

All in all, most pet applications (other than normal dog and cat applications) are decided on a case by case basis and if you have any specific pets that require relocation, we can certainly assist with this.
