Chaplain, Col(s) G. Lloyd Woodbury is the Command Chaplain, U.S. Air Forces Central Command, Southwest Asia. He advises and represents the AFCENT Commander on all aspects of the Chaplain Corps mission in direct support of all operations to include Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, INHERENT RESOLVE, RESOLUTE SUPPORT, and FREEDOM'S SENTINEL. He provides functional oversight and ensures pastoral care to Chaplain Corps personnel supporting 28,500 Airmen in 14 locations in the area of responsibility covering Central and Southwest Asia. He develops theater-specific policies and procedures, and establishes and validates Chaplain Corps manpower requirements. He coordinates with CENTCOM and joint counterparts to ensure appropriate war fighter support.

Chaplain Woodbury is a native of Charleston, South Carolina. He was ordained as a Southern Baptist minister in 1988 and entered active duty in the Air Force in November 1994. He has served as Protestant Chaplain, Senior Protestant Chaplain, Division Chief, Wing Chaplain and Staff Chaplain.
