COLONEL BRIAN DUFFY

Colonel Brian Duffy is the Chief of Staff for United States Air Forces Central Command, Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar. He directs 2,400 Joint and Coalition personnel from seven nations, enabling Air Force operations across the United States Central Command's Area of Responsibility. Additionally, he leads 18 Directorates in executing the Combined Forces Air Component Commander's intent, answering critical inquiries, and providing executive level recommendations.

Colonel Duffy, entered the Air Force in August 1989 as a graduate of the Air Force ROTC program at the Virginia Military Institute. A career civil engineer, he has served in a variety of positions at base, major command, and Air Staff levels, and has commanded two squadrons, a group, a joint base, and a wing. His contingency experience includes command of a civil engineer squadron and service as a deputy director and deputy commander in support of Headquarters United States Forces-Afghanistan. Prior to his current assignment, was the Vice Commander, Air Force Installation and Mission Support Center, Joint Base Andrews, Maryland. In this capacity, he assisted the commander in establishing the center, the single intermediate-level headquarters providing installation and mission support capabilities to Air Force installations.
