Al Udeid Air Base COVID-19 Quick Reference Guide

Protect the Prevent the Ensure Mission Success

In light of the Novel Coronavirus pandemic, the 379th Air Expeditionary Wing commander has declared a public health emergency. This Quick Reference Guide will give you the basic information you need in order to be in compliance with current force health protection measures. - All incoming personnel assigned to AUAB will be quarantined for 14 days in Quarantine Town (Q-Town) immediately after clearing customs.
 - Additional quarantine information, including a list of mandatory items you will need to bring can be found here.
- Transient personnel not assigned to AUAB will be billeted in Transient Town (T-Town) for the duration of their stay at AUAB.
- Members assigned to Q-Town and T-Town will not interact with the rest of the base population.
 Any members violating this policy are subject to disciplinary action under the UCMJ.

Both Q-Town and T-Town have their own specific rules of engagement. Members billeted in these areas will be briefed on the ROEs upon assignment.

- Cloth masks are required at AUAB. Masks must be worn in all common areas where two or more personnel gather. These include but are not limited to:
 - o The entire BPC Mall Complex (not just BX), to include post office, barber shop, etc.
 - o DFACs and grab-n-gos to include lines outside & inside
 - All customer service areas and functions (includes customers and customer service reps)
 - Anytime there is more than one person in a vehicle (busses included)
 - o In all gyms until exercise begins (i.e. wear until you get on the machine)
 - o The Chapel during all services
 - The Innovation Center
 - Anywhere a line forms inside or outside (social distancing still required unless impossible)
 - All work centers where safe to do so (unless in single person office)
- Limit social behaviors such as hand-shaking, physical contact, and visits to any locations other than work centers and personal living quarters.
- Maintain six feet of social distancing with other members, both indoors and outdoors, unless impossible.
- Off base travel is prohibited until further notice.
 - Members who must travel of base in performance of their official duties must route their travel request through their chain of command.
 - o Travel to off base medical appointments will be routed through the 379 EMDG.
- All non-essential gatherings are prohibited.
